CODE OF CONDUCT

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

- A. No student shall act in a manner that, on campus or off campus, brings discredit to The Premo School.
- B. No student shall display physically aggressive behavior, assault, harassment, intimidation, threats, gossip, or coercion.
- C. No student shall engage in conduct that creates conditions that endanger the physical health of any person.
- D. No students shall use language that spreads ill will towards or about another.
- E. No student shall use language that indicates another should cause themselves harm.
- F. No student shall plagiarize, cheat, or steal.
- G. No student shall engage in unwelcome or persistent conduct that the student knows, or ought to reasonably know, would cause another person to feel demeaned, intimidated, or harassed.

H. No student shall store, possess, or use: real (or replica) firearms, knives, or other weapons.

I. No students shall store, possess, or use explosives (including fireworks), ammunition, toxic or otherwise dangerous materials, alcohol or drugs.

We make every effort to work with students and families to ensure that every enrolled child is successful in our program. Consequences for violation of the Code of Conduct include expulsion, which is at the sole option of the school. If a student is expelled, tuition to date is not refundable and the remainder of the semester's tuition is immediately due.

I understand and give permission for my child to participate in unstructured/unrestricted outdoor free play in outdoor space in order to socialize and experience new perspectives. Teachers are present to help monitor free play, but allow children the freedom to interact and explore with minimal adult interaction. Unstructured/unrestricted outdoor free play includes, but is not limited to: climbing trees, running, creating games, playing with sticks, swinging on the rope swing, digging in the mud, getting dirty, using tools, playing in the garden, problem solving, playing in the woods, fort building, and exploring the nature around them.
